#### 1. PRIVACY STATEMENT

The Office of the Valuer-General (hereafter referred to as "the OVG") respects the privacy of all users who visit our websites or communicate electronically with us. The Privacy Statement therefore provides an explanation on how the OVG gathers and disseminates information on the OVG website.

### 2. INFORMATION COLLECTED AUTOMATICALLY BY THE OVG

We do, however, record your activities whilst on the site, such as your Internet Protocol (IP) address, browser type and pages visited. Log files are used to analyse website usage and may be kept in an aggregated and anonymized form for historical records. This helps us to align our content to the needs of our audience. The OVG does not share the collected information with any other organization, except where required by law.

## 3. INFORMATION AND USE THEREOF

The information provided by you is used to get in contact with you in response to your query and to improve the OVG websites or, in case of a conference or webinar, to register you as a participant. No personal information submitted by you will be shared or made public without your prior consent or unless required by law.

## 4. COOKIES

Some of our websites may use cookies to store any preferences you may have expressed. Cookies are like tokens for a specific web page that the web server stores on your computer.
